 - vii. Jess Frank is interested in being a project manager for conference, although she has not started yet.
 - viii. It was noted that an email needs to go out to the members of the organization
 - ix. It was also noted that we need to recruit board members for 2014 as not everyone would be back
 - x. ACTION Sean to work with Jess on developing a new schedule based on conversations had during the meeting



xi. ACTION – Jess to develop sponsorship package, content plan and budget and have it launched within the next two weeks

8. Budget update

- a. Sean mentioned that flight costs are built into the new budget. Moreover, forecasting is done and Sean believes the outlook is good.
- b. Ideally external funds can be brought in to support the CFTN.
- c. Sean mentioned people are impressed with the amount that the CFTN has covered.
- d. Zack asked to what extent will EWB continue funding?
- e. Sean replied that Boris and Sal are very happy with the CFTN's progress and they recommended putting together a 3-5 year plan. Sean feels that the CFTN is in good shape. EWB has been a cornerstone of funding.

9. Campaigns

- a. Fair Trade Campus week
 - i. Difficult to organize considering that Sean has been organizing this during the summer.
 - ii. FT Towns and Campuses will be announced every day each week. McGill announcement on Sept 23rd, Edmonton a FT Town on Sept 26th. Brock and Selkirk on the 24th and 25th.
 - iii. Guide, application, and instruction sheets will be available in hardcopy.
 - iv. All displays and banners will be standardized. Michael Zelmer is working on it.
- b. Fair Trade Halloween
 - i. Crowd funding for minis?
 - 1. Sean is working with Flavia on this initiative.
 - 2. Flavia might have 50,000 of the minis.

10. Program Development

- a. FT Campuses guide, forms and design templates set to go!
- b. FT Towns Guide and forms, website template in the works
 - i. In terms of development the FT Towns forms, templates, and application will be the next item.

11. Partner Engagement

- a. Fairtrade Canada governance update and AGM plans
 - Focus upon governance reforms. Nadia and Sean participate on the governance committee. Things have progressed really well in establishing a new process for transparency.
 - ii. Sean hopes that FT Canada will accept committes recommendations for improved transparency will be ratified.
 - iii. CSOs, Liscensee, and Independents can become voting members.
 - iv. Nancy asked whether board members terms can be limited.
 - v. There will be a cap-length for their board appointments.
 - vi. Kaan believes it is worth thanking the board members which do revolve out.

12. Upcoming announcements

a. Edmonton, Selkirk College, McGill University & Brock University



- i. Bruce asked whether there are any confrontations with Starbucks and Tim Hortons at Brock, and Sean replied that at SFU, Starbucks may be making a huge announcement, possibly switching to a FT espresso (unconfirmed).
- ii. Sean reminded the committee that there will be 6 FT Campuses.

13. Discussion Items

- a. Crowd funding options?
- b. Organizing a Co-op visit trip to Latin America
 - i. Sean and Randy from Discovery Organics had a discussion regarding a co-op visit to Latin America.
 - ii. At the idea stage at the moment and CFTN can launch into a crowd-funded initiative, possibly of even being a fundraising opportunity for the CFTN.
 - iii. Brock university students are very interested in the co-op visit.

14. Regional Updates

- a. Nadia FTT is getting new members on board. Mid –October recruitment. FT App is being developed, resembling FT USA app.
- b. Bruce –Peterborough seems to be quiet; however, responsibility has been passed along. Event with Stephen Lewis foundation is happening on October 18th. Lots of entertainers.
- c. Zack –Winnipeg is holding a FT Challenge usually held in the winter. Buy Nothing Day is occurring with huge turnout. A buycott is happening as opposed to a Boycott. FT Manitoba has a new logo available on the internet. New website will appear next week. Latin American tour will happen within the next year or two.
- d. Sasha—Now in Ontario and will remain for remainder of year it was noted that an imbalance has now occurred, where we have three in one province board agreed to remedy this at the AGM in January.
- e. Nancy—Met today with the president of the student union, reassured Nancy that things are in motion. FT week, nothing is happening per say.
- f. Kaan—FTV had a variety of volunteer orientation session. SFU and UBC are excited about the FT Campus Week. FT Campus week is being leveraged as a means to attract new EWB volunteers.
- g. Sean—Has a meeting with Trinity Western University as they are interested in becoming a FT Campus. Kwantlen University is putting on an entire conference on October 29th along with a social event. At UNBC, there are two volunteers who are interested in advancing the FT Campus push. FT Vancouver will be having a FT Olive Oil night. Looks like FTV is growing.
- h. Zack mentioned it would be interesting to know what resources are required to proceed with FT advocacy efforts. Some groups may have too many resources or too little.
- i. Globe and Mail article was a hit with most people.
